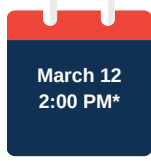
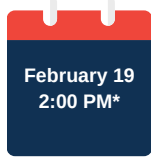

Lithium-ion Battery Safety

Tiny Fire and Emergency Services has joined the Ontario Fire Marshal's 'Charged for LiFE' public education campaign to raise awareness about lithium-ion battery safety. These batteries can be found in many household technology products such as cellphones, smartwatches, cordless vacuums, e-bikes, laptops, and power tools such as drills.

- Batteries - Only purchase certified batteries and continuously monitor the battery health
- Charging - Lithium-ion batteries can be a fire hazard when improperly charged (too hot or too cold)
- Tampering - Never attempt to modify, tamper with, or build your own lithium-ion batteries
- Disposal - Lithium-ion batteries are household hazardous waste and should never be placed in the garbage

Winter Maintenance Reminders

Snow Removal

- Crews start with the busiest roads to help ensure Fire and Emergency Services can reach those in need. After the main roads are cleared, crews will move to residential areas.
- Do not deposit snow onto the roadway or sidewalks, or across the road into the ditch.

Winter Parking

- Avoid parking on the street during snow events.
- Avoid parking on or near the sidewalk to give our sidewalk plow drivers space to work.

Hazards

- Ensure children refrain from building tunnels or forts inside snow banks by roadways.
- Place garbage and recycling bins back from the road to avoid being damaged by plows, and keep them off of sidewalks.

We have noticed an increase in mortgage companies that no longer offer a property tax payment service. **It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure that property taxes are paid. As per the Municipal Act, penalties and interest due to late payments cannot be waived.**

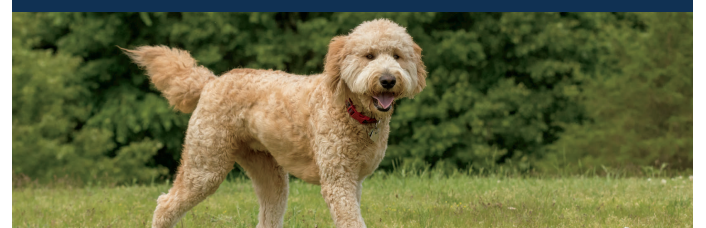
