## Lithium-ion Battery Safety

Tiny Fire and Emergency Services has joined the Ontario Fire Marshal's 'Charged for LiFE' public education campaign to raise awareness about lithium-ion battery safety. These batteries can be found in many household technology products such as cellphones, smartwatches,

cordless vacuums, e-bikes, laptops, and power tools such as drills.

- Batteries Only purchase certified batteries and continuously monitor the battery health
- Charging Lithium-ion batteries can be a fire hazard when improperly charged (too hot or too cold)
- Tampering Never attempt to modify, tamper with, or build your own lithium-ion batteries
- Disposal Lithium-ion batteries are household hazardous waste and should never be placed in the garbage

#### **Snow Removal**

## **Changes to Mortgage Company Tax Payment Services**

We have noticed an increase in mortgage companies that no longer offer a property tax payment service. It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure that property taxes are paid. As per the Municipal Act, penalties and interest due to late payments cannot be waived.

- Pre-authorized payment (PAP) plan
- Online or telephone banking
- At financial institutions
- By credit card
- In-person/drop-box
